



WHAT LABOR HASN'T TOLD YOU ABOUT ITS ETS...

LABOR'S EMISSIONS TRADING SCHEME WILL COST AUSTRALIAN JOBS AND HOUSEHOLDS.

- Average annual household electricity bills will rise by 25%, or \$280¹
- Australian food and grocery prices will rise by as much as 5%²
- Regional Australia will lose 126,000 jobs³
- Meat processing costs will increase⁴, pushing up retail meat prices
- The farm cash income for an average beef farm will fall by over 60% if agriculture's emissions are included⁵
- Even if agriculture is not covered, the indirect cost for dairy farmers will be \$6000 - \$9000 per farm⁵
- Sixteen coal mines will close with 10,000 jobs lost⁶
- Overall, there will be 23,500 jobs lost in the mining industry⁷
- The economies of Gippsland, Geelong, central-west Queensland, central Western Australia, the Kimberley and Whyalla/Port Pirie will each shrink by more than 20%³
- **And there will be no reduction in global greenhouse gas emissions**
